

## LAKEWOOD HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION TENNIS RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. COURT RESERVATIONS. Tennis courts may be reserved no more than 24 hours in advance by a homeowner signing up for a court on the sign-up sheets located outside Court #3. Courts are available on a first-come, first serve basis for reservations. If a court is reserved and the reserver does not show within 15 minutes of their reservation time, the court is forfeited to any homeowner that wishes to use it.
2. REGISTRATION. Courts may be reserved for 1-½ hours for singles play, and 2 hours for doubles play. When signing up for a court, indicate the length of time the court will be used.
3. GUESTS. Each homeowner may only reserve one court for their use. They may invite guests to play on that court, but the homeowner must be present in the tennis court area while the guests are there. Under no circumstances should the homeowner leave the tennis court area while guests are using a court. When the homeowner leaves, all his/her subsequent guests must leave as well.
4. ENFORCEMENT. The tennis community in Lakewood bears the first responsibility for enforcing these rules. Lakewood does not have its own police force, and the manager cannot be in all places at all times. If you are on the courts and/or see a violation of these rules, please bring it to the attention of the member before you bring it up to the manager of Recreation Committee. Give the homeowner a chance to rectify the oversight of the rules before it becomes a major issue. Lakewood is a community of neighbors!

### TENNIS ETIQUETTE

1. HONOR COURT RESERVATIONS. All players should plan to arrive at the court shortly before the scheduled time of play. Should you find that you would be unable to honor a court reservation, please notify the manager or the Recreational Facility Committee.
2. AN OCCUPIED COURT. When waiting to play on a court that is occupied, please do so quietly and unobtrusively in order that players will not be distracted. It is a gesture of courtesy to allow the players to complete the game in which they are engaged.
3. CLOSE ALL GATES. Please close and latch all gates when entering and leaving.
4. COURT NEATNESS. Ball cans, can tops; paper cups and other trash should be deposited in the trashcans upon completion of play.

Pets, skateboards, and glass containers are strictly prohibited on the tennis courts.

Violations of any of these rules can result in loss of tennis privileges.
